To be eligible for consideration under the Māori admission scheme you must:

- (i) be Māori;
  - (ii) have achieved at least a grade of C+ in each of LAW 121G and LAW 131 **AND** completed and passed 6 non-law courses (90 points)
  - (iii) have completed the on-line Application for Admission – Part II by **1 December 2011**;
  - (iv) return this form, to the **Faculty of Law, Private Bag 92019, Auckland 1142**, as instructed with a covering letter by, **Monday 5 December 2011**;
  - (v) attend an interview which you will be allocated on either **13 December 2011** or **14 December 2011**. **Interviews** will be set up over the phone. If you have been interviewed previously you may still need to be interviewed again; and
  - (vi) attend an information session. **Wednesday 30 November 2011**, at **6:00pm** in the **Stone Lecture Theatre**

Please read the following before completing the Ancestry section of the Application:

### Ethnicity/Ancestry

Ethnicity is the ethnic group or groups that people identify with or feel they belong to, and is a measure of cultural affiliation, as opposed to race, ancestry, nationality or citizenship. Ethnicity is self-perceived and people can belong to more than one ethnic group. A person's ethnicity may not necessarily match their ancestry. Ancestry is a biological and historical concept and refers to a person's blood descent. You are eligible for consideration under the TAS (Māori) if you are of **indigenous Māori ancestry**, and are a citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand.

### Certification of Ancestry

The certification of your Māori ancestry must be completed by a Church Elder, Community Leader, or Iwi Kaumātua who knows your family. The Certifier must be of Māori descent and cannot be your sibling, spouse, parent or grandparent.

Should it be necessary to seek clarification of any of the information submitted, we will contact the named certifier. TAS (Māori) eligibility will not be considered until this form has been completed and any verification concerns have been addressed.

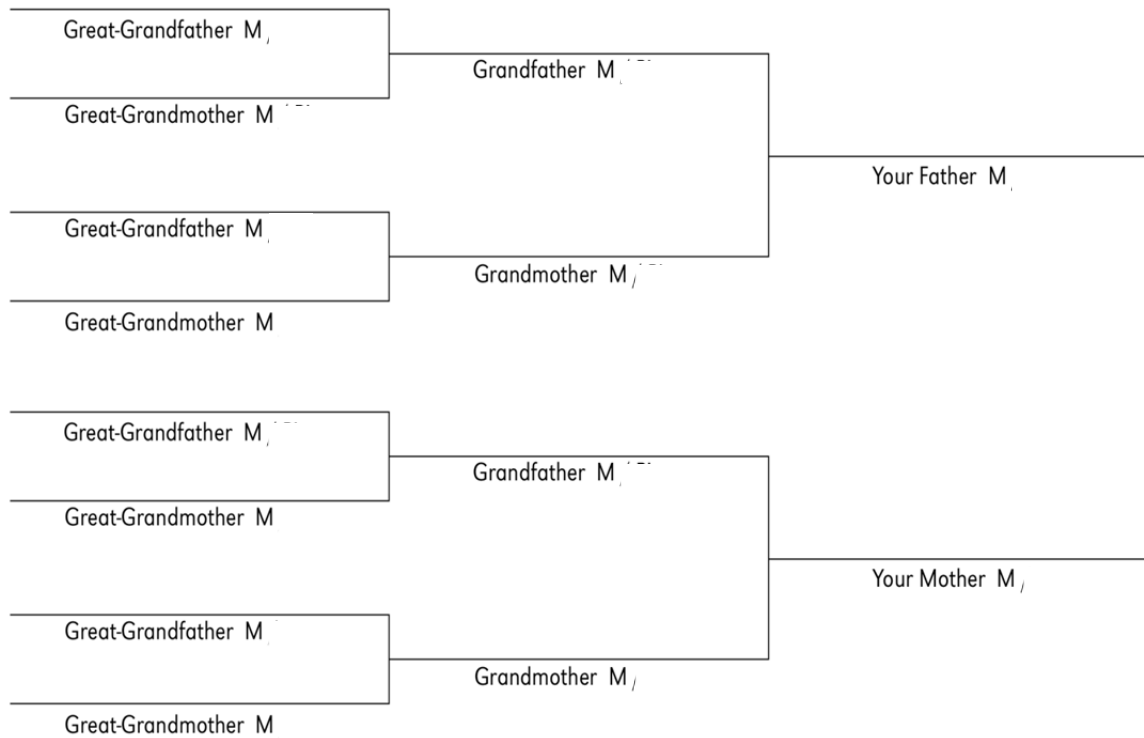
