1. The process.

- (i) You will be applying to The University of Auckland <http://www.auckland.ac.nz/>. Complete an *Online Application* by clicking the "Apply Now" link. The programme you are applying for is: *Programme Type: Certificate / Undergraduate Diploma; Academic Programme: Grad Cert in Law / Graduate Diploma in Law. Major or Specialisation: Law (Specialisation).* Further details of applying for GCLAW / GDLAW are available overleaf. You will be requested by the Auckland University Admissions Office to forward your official academic transcript and other documents.
- (ii) You also need to complete this form and return in hard copy to **Suranjika Tittawella**, Faculty of Law, University of Auckland, Private Bag 92019, Auckland.

2. Submit with this hard copy GCLAW/GDLAW Application Form:

- A **photocopy** of your academic transcript to the Faculty of Law; and
- If the GCLAW/GDLAW courses are for the Council of Legal Education (CLE), attach a copy of your correspondence from CLE; or
- If you are completing an LLB degree from another university, attach the approval from your home university.

3. Note about applying for compulsory law courses. There is a **deadline of 1st December** if you wish to apply for the following compulsory course for COP: LAW 201, Criminal Law; LAW 211, Public Law; LAW 231, Tort Law; LAW 241, Contract Law; LAW 301, Land Law; LAW 306, Equity. You will need to meet the Grade Point Average set by the Law Faculty Selection Committee before your application can be approved if it is for one of the compulsory courses.

Note: Failure to submit required documents as stated above will delay processing of your application.

4. Applications for all law courses will only be considered if there are places available in the courses.

5. If your application is approved by the Faculty of Law, enrolment will be undertaken by the Faculty.
